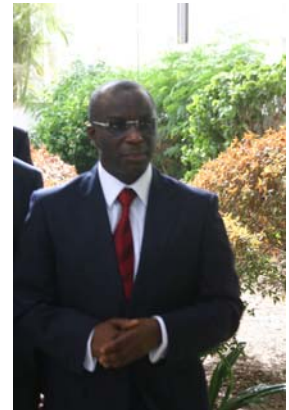




The Honourable **M. Abdoulaye DIOP**
