

## **Dr. Meenal Shrivastava**

Assistant Professor, Political Economy/Global Studies

Meenal Shrivastava joined Athabasca University in April 2006 as Assistant Professor. She is the Academic Coordinator for the programmes on Political Economy and Global Studies. She was a Senior Lecturer in the department of International Relations at the University of the Witwatersrand, Johannesburg (Wits University) from Feb. 2000 to March 2006. She studied at Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU), New Delhi from 1993-98 for her M Phil and Ph D degrees at the School of International Studies.

She taught Graduate and Post-Graduate courses in the field of International Political Economy and International Relations. Four Doctoral, ten Masters and several other graduate research degrees were completed under her in the six years at Wits University. While at Wits, she was awarded several research grants. She served as an external evaluator for a number of universities and research entities in South Africa and periodically conducted guest modules for trainee diplomats at the Department of Foreign Affairs, Pretoria.

Her research has led to many academic publications, paper presentations in international conferences, media opinion pieces and guest lectures in South Africa, India, Canada and elsewhere. Her research interests span the World Trade Organisation, Globalisation, Environmental Management/Politics, Role of Technology, Gender studies, Contemporary South Africa and India, and IR theories. She is currently the Editor of *Politikon: South African Journal of Political Studies* (Oxfordshire: Routledge)(2007-2009); on the Editorial Board of the *International Environmental Review* (Massachusetts: IEA) since 2002; and was the Book Reviews editor for *Politikon* (2004-2006).
